Journey With Christ Program

Created for parents and children from age 3 through 8th grade/Confirmation. Parents/family/adults are expected to attend catechesis designed for them while children are in their sessions.

You can attend at either campus – St Peter or St Joan of Arc – there are many times available.

All grades will be available at all session times.

There are two (2) semesters – each with a 5-week in-person session and a 5-week home activity session.

Children's in-person sessions will be based on the topics presented to the parents, creating consistent content that families can experience together – no textbooks.

At-home activities will be designed to engage the whole family, no matter how many various ages in the family.

Parents attend parent catechesis sessions in the Saint Peter McEwan Gym or the Saint Joan of Arc Social Hall while their children are in their grade-appropriate classrooms.

Volunteers may choose a 5-week in-person session with their family or choose the full 10-week session.

Volunteers will not attend the parent catechesis, their participation expectation is met by volunteering.

Families with multiple children in the program, on different days, will attend only one parent catechesis session each week.

Childcare will be offered for children too young for the program.
